

Perry Wood Sports Funding Spend 2016-2017

The Sports Funding has provided new and exciting opportunities for the children of Perry Wood. The rationale for Sports Fund spending this academic year is to build on the successful strategies of the past while developing a richer and wider sporting context for our pupils.

To achieve these aims we intend to take a multi-pronged approach to spending.

1. Continue our membership of local cluster including funding a part share in a member of staff to organise tournaments, events and leagues with our local schools.
2. Develop a GST sporting calendar of events
3. Identifying and nurturing individual talent in our own school.
4. Improving sports provision for all within school.

The costings

Sports Funding total for 2016-2017: £9680.

1. £1690: Existing agreement with local cluster; release time, teacher training, equipment, coaching.
2. £ 2560: Transport locally, regionally and nationally. Transport to inspirational events
3. £660: Sports kit, spare kit, cheerleading kit and subscription fees to netball and football leagues.
4. £3290: Supplying and erecting of new goalposts
5. £1200: New PE equipment, sports badges, Boccia set, sports awards.
6. £280: Educational books and resources to support staff teaching of PE across the school
