

Perry Wood Sports Funding Spend 2015/16.

The Sports Funding has provided new and exciting opportunities for the children of Perry Wood. The rationale for Sports Fund spending this academic year is build on the successful strategies of the past while developing a richer and wider sporting context for our pupils.

To achieve these aims we intend to take a multi-pronged approach to spending.

1. Continue our membership of local cluster including funding a part share in a member of staff to organise tournaments, events and leagues with our local schools.
2. Develop a GST sporting calendar of event- the Griffin Olympiad- involving both the Midlands schools and the wider Trust.
3. Identifying and nurturing individual talent in our own school.
4. Improving sports provision for all within school.

The costings

Sports Funding total: £9000.

1. £1620 Existing agreement with local cluster; release time, transport, equipment, coaching.
2. £ 2500 Olympiad; sports kit, new equipment, transport locally, regionally and nationally. This will involve several year groups so the school team kit costs could be considerable.
3. £500 Individual endeavour: fees, sports kit, new equipment, transport locally, regionally and nationally.
4. £2500 New equipment in bulk, spare kit, sports coaching, transport to inspirational events
5. £1880 Contingency for supply cover for meetings/events undiscovered talent, unknown total for Olympiad.
