## Ks2 VIPERS to be discussed, but not explicitly taught Read aloud 4 x 20 mins/week Reading for pleasure to be encouraged and modelled Reading for pleasure (book club) – children to have opportunity to explore a book corner and choose books (guided by CT) Children read aloud in a secure inclusive environment using partner reading Build knowledge of real world, text types and structure Reading intervention is targeted and timely

## KS1

Identify a core set of poems Children to read and re-read stories with CT; children to call out known parts of the story Reading sessions timetabled and explicitly taught each day Reading for pleasure (book club) – children to have opportunity to explore a book corner and choose books (guided by CT) Language rich – increased language exposure

Read aloud 4 x 20 mins/week

## EYFS

Early identification of struggling readers with prompt interventions Increased exposure to words and language Accurate decoding priority through SSP Create a language rich environment Poems/songs with regular repetition Read aloud and build knowledge through drama, role play and experiences
