## Pupils and parents

Staff can expect pupils learning remotely to:

- Complete work daily and to the deadline set by teachers
- Seek help from teachers if they need it
- Alert teachers if they're not able to complete work
- Work should be completed to a high standard – presentation, handwriting, spelling etc
- Follow the Acceptable Use Policy for working online.
- During registration sessions, children will remain on mute unless directed by the teacher.
- Children should be dressed appropriately (no nightwear and appropriately covered up)

Staff can expect parents to:

- Make the school aware if their child is sick or otherwise can't complete work – via the School Office as usual.
- Seek help from the school if they need it –staff will point parents towards key information to support if they're struggling.
- Be respectful when making any complaints or concerns known to staff
- Children to be working in a quiet work space (not bedrooms).
- Registration times are only for children and teachers to communicate.
- If you wish to contact class teachers, this should be between the hours of 8:30am and 4.30pm.
